

Pursuant to article 17 paragraph 4 of the Law on Lobbying (Official Gazette of Montenegro 52/14), the Ministry of Justice adopted the

Rulebook on the form and content of request for issuance of authorization for conducting lobbying activities

The Rulebook was published in the Official Gazette of Montenegro, 52/2015, dated 11 September 2015, and has entered into force on 19 September 2015.

Article 1

The request for issuance of the authorization for conducting lobbying activities (hereinafter: request for issuance of authorization) shall contain the data and be submitted in the form prescribed by this Rulebook.

Article 2

The request for issuance of authorization shall contain the name of the state authority to which the request is being submitted, the title "REQUEST FOR ISSUANCE OF AUTHORIZATION FOR CONDUCTING LOBBYING ACTIVITY", the fields for the entry of data on the applicant (name and surname, unique master citizen number/personal identification number of the citizen, place of residence, contact phone and e-mail address), area of lobbying, place and date of the submission of request, as well as the signature of the applicant and the list of documents being submitted with the request, in accordance with the Law on Lobbying.

Article 3

The form of the request for issuing the authorization shall constitute an integral part of this Rulebook.

Article 4

This Rulebook shall enter into force on the eighth day from the date of being published in the Official Gazette of Montenegro.

- Evidence that the applicant has not been pronounced the safeguard measure, prohibiting him or her from carrying out activities in the area in which he or she lobbies.

When submitting the request for extension of validity of the authorization, it is not necessary to submit the documents referred to in items 2 and 3.
